#### **Note from Fr. Felix:**

*Happy Belated New Year to all my great friends at St. Mary's Parish. Indeed I had planned to visit the US next July. However, by the looks of things, that is not feasible on account of the University Lecturer's strike which took all of October, November and December. The University is trying to make up for the lost time this January to finish what should have been taught last year. So, the second semester has not started and won't start till March 2012. As a result the semester will only end in June instead of May as it normally does. This leaves me with one month to finish correcting exams and a month to rest before school starts in August.*

*We have had a long drought all last year from June till December. As a result people did not plant their fields. There has been some rains since December but only good for vegetables. Corn which is a staple food crop should have been sown between August and November. It has been hot and humid. Usually we have dry heat. It's unusual to have humid heat. - Fr. Felix*
