7 Tips for Thanksgiving

1. Celebrate Thanksgiving by going to Mass. Eucharist in Greek means Thanksgiving. That's what Jesus did at the Last Supper, he took bread, gave thanks and broke it...
2. Thank some people who you think deserve a word of thanks from you either through email/facebook/twitter/text whatever.
3. Count your blessings – literally. I am sure everyone of us can count some blessings.
4. Find a thanksgiving prayer (there are many beautiful thanksgiving prayers), print it and take it with you to pray before the Thanksgiving meal. Don't be embarrassed to pray publicly. Invite others to pray silently as you lead the prayer. You can personalize the prayer to the family situation.
5. If you can invite someone who may not be having a thanksgiving meal or may be someone who is alone (priest, neighbor or homebound) or prepare a plate and give who is alone.
6. At the end of the meal, pray the Magnificat. It's of the most beautiful prayers of thanksgiving.
7. Before going to bed, say a prayer of Thanksgiving on behalf of all those who don't pray or might not pray that day.

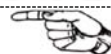

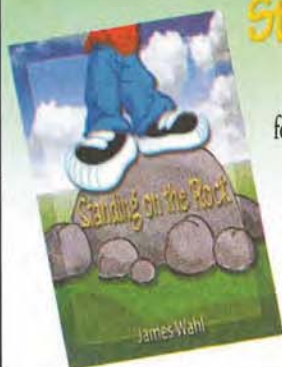
