Pastor's Desk

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

As they say, ready or not, here it comes again! No, I am not talking about more snow. I am talking about the Season of Lent. This coming Wednesday, we begin the penitential season of Lent. Ashes will be blessed and distributed at all the masses. Mass times can be found in this bulletin.

The season of Lent is also a good time for us to add more spiritual time to our lives. As a way of helping to make Lent more of what it's supposed to be, I want to encourage you to take part in the opportunities for spiritual growth that we will have during Lent, viz.: Mass during the week, Stations of the Cross with evening prayer (vespers), adoration and confessions during adoration on Fridays, Lenten Retreats by Judy Hehr at St. Peter & Paul Church (flier at the back of the church), Lenten Penance Service (will be announced), personal prayer & Alms-giving. I encourage you to participate in our 'Operation Rice Bowl' activity. Your Lenten sacrifices, however small they might be, will help the needy over 100 countries through Catholic Relief Services. Happy lent!

### Lenten Regulations

Catholics are asked to preserve the penitential purpose and character of Lent, which begins this Wednesday. The following are the Lenten Regulations.

- Catholics who have celebrated their 14th birthday are bound to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday, Good Friday and each Friday of Lent.
- Catholics who have celebrated their 18th birthday, in addition to abstaining from meat, should fast on Ash Wednesday & Good Friday, which is taking one full meal & smaller quantities of food at the other 2 meals.
- The obligation to fast ceases with one's 59th birthday.

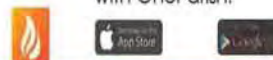

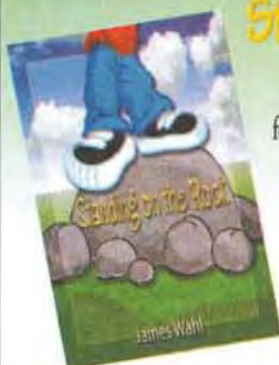
