Pastor's Desk

Dear Brothers & Sisters in Christ,

Our last fiscal year 2018-2019 has ended at the end of June. Please find the parish finance report for the year in the bulletin insert. I would like to thank all of you for supporting the parish with your generous contributions. In the past fiscal year we've done quite a few things in the parish such as:

- Landscaping in front of the church and down by the Cafeteria and the Rectory.
- We also painted the windows of the Rectory with the help of the seminarians and the Prayer 7 Action group. The parish council is currently caulking the windows and re-installing them.
- The Cemetery Board is planning on installing a new fence around the cemetery.
- Early September, we will be completing the south-side steps to the sacristy after which we will be installing the handrail to the ramp to the basement.
- We will be levelling the levelling the little Island on the southside of the church and rock it. We will also be installing a fence on the retaining wall.
- We are also looking into installing a handicap door-opener to the north-west door of the church.
- In the past fiscal year we also completed the Archdiocesan Capital Campaign. The 25% that will be sent back to the parish has been earmarked for the re-wiring of the church, a project to be completed in the near future.

I'd like to take this opportunity to thank especially our bookkeeper Mary Beth, the finance & parish council members & the maintenance committee and all the money counters. In a special way, I'd like to thank our outgoing finance council members Gary Schmitz and Ed Mohny for their service to the parish and welcome the new members Marsha Korber and Bob Macke to join Rob Rottinghaus, Leroy Strathman & Evelyn Rottinghaus in the council.

Treasures from our Tradition

The wonderful diversity of life and worship among Roman Catholics of East and West is an example of God writing straight with crooked lines. The steady hand of the villainous Emperor Diocletian drew a line across Europe and Africa that split the empire in two, and for the most part determined how Christians would worship two thousand years later.

Italy's heel and the far northern city of Trieste fell on the Eastern side, and have had a form of Eastern liturgy ever since. Constantinople, which soon became the seat of the Roman Empire, became a base for Christianizing the East up to Russia and Poland. Poland was on the Eastern side, but a series of wars and medieval mayhem pushed the religious boundary back to the Ukraine, and Poland remains an outpost of the Latin Church to this day.

An old rule of thumb declared that whatever religion was observed by the local prince, the people had to follow. This gave rise to persecution and migration as people sought toleration for their expressions of faith. In the United States, we are accustomed to peaceful collaboration among Christians of East and West, a situation that challenges churches that still feel the pinch of age-old division. -James Field, Copyright © J. - **Write letters:** It usually seems easier to talk things through but the discipline of writing can help both spouses articulate their thoughts and share more effectively.
- Learn new habits : New relationship skills take some effort to learn, but they release so much joy!

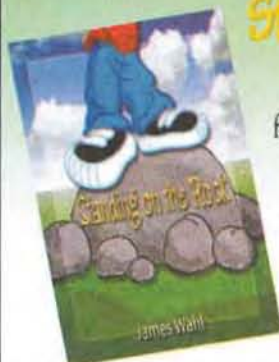
