## Treasures from our Tradition

The readings today center on mindfulness, awareness of where we stand in God's plan. The mountain of Sinai carries a message of the majesty and distance of God, while Jesus' presence as host of the banquet speaks of intimacy and mystery. September's shadow calls us all to mindfulness as we prepare to return to life outside of summer. The Christian life holds these two places of knowledge of God in careful balance. Even in the accounts of the Passion we see the table of the upper room in balance with the Mount of Olives.

*Altar* means "high place," yet it is also a table. The former liturgy of the Latin Rite began with the priest bowing at the foot of the altar's 3 steps, chanting *Introibo ad altare Dei*, or "I will go to the altar of God," followed by the altar servers' response, "The God who gives joy to my youth." Many parishioners can recall and recite this scene by heart. As with so many things in liturgy, there are layers of meaning in our worship. The altar evokes memories of the high places once reserved for encounter with the holy, and the intimacy of the table where hospitality draws us to share food & drink. -James Field, Copyright © J. S. ### Marriage Minute

Oftentimes, we misuse the word humility. True humility is seeing oneself in light of God's mission for us. For married couples, one of the greatest ways to practice this foundational virtue is to put God's mission of marriage at the top of the priority list. One practical thing you can do to put your spouse first is to use their preferred love language instead of your own:

- **Words of Affirmation:** Intentionally affirm your spouse through speech or thoughtful notes.
- **Physical Touch:** Offer your spouse a back rub after dinner instead of jumping into cleanup.
- **Gifts:** Offer thoughtful gifts (not expensive).
- **Quality Time:** Sacrifice time online or watching TV to spend time with your spouse doing what they would like to do.
- **Acts of Service:** Quietly do a chore that your spouse normally does.
