Pastor's Desk

Dear Parishioners,

We know that presently in the news we are hearing about the Coronavirus threat. As of this writing there has been no reported incident of the virus in our state. This surely does not mean that precautions should not be taken.

Here are a few things to keep in mind:

- The extraordinary ministers of Holy Communion are advised to sanitize hands before and after distributing Holy Communion as always.
- If you are sick do not come to Eucharist. One does not sin if one is ill and is absent from Eucharist. Come back to Eucharist when you recover.
- If you are coughing, sneezing, or feel under the weather, please abstain from receiving from the cup.
- During the flu season, receiving the Eucharist in the hand and not on the tongue is highly encouraged.

Blessed Sacrament will be exposed soon after the Mass and adoration will continue till 3:00pm. Each family in the parish is encouraged to take a 30 minute time slot for adoration. The following order is as per the pictorial directory.
