God's Plan

Saint Peter speaks to us twice today. In the first reading, we hear an excerpt from his sermon on Pentecost; in the second, part of his first letter. Once a frightened, uneducated fisherman who often said just the wrong thing, now Peter is speaking what he knows to be true. Everything Jesus had said now makes sense. His death and rising were all part of God's plan, and our faith and hope can be centered on God.

Today's Gospel tells the story of Jesus' walk to Emmaus with two of the disciples. Frightened, sad, and confused, the two of them don't recognize Jesus, who tells them what we heard Peter say above: All this had to happen as part of God's plan. In the end, these disciples recognize Jesus as we are to recognize him—in the breaking of the bread.

Dressing up for Mass even when it's virtual

As Catholics, we believe that God comes down to meet us at every Mass. At this difficult time, when the circumstances don't allow us to come together as a community, many Catholics are participating in Mass via live stream. This is totally a new experience for all of us. During this time, the most important thing for us is not to give up on Mass, so we can persevere in your relationship with God. Our conscious & active participation, however we can, is very crucial to make the virtual (live-stream) mass a fruitful celebration.

It is said that no single factor affects the liturgy as much as the attitude and the style of the participants. Small gestures can help bring a sense of sacredness to our worship. One of the ways to increase this sacredness and make it more fruitful is a well-dressed self. When we go to Mass at our own parishes, we usually try to dress at least as nicely as we do for work. Despite the fact that these days, due to social distancing, we can't physically attend church, we can find great comfort in dressing up to view the Mass. Of course, there's no one to see or care whether we are in any particular state of decorum or disarray. But getting ready for Mass as we usually would, provides a sense of normalcy to our disordered life-style. Maintaining our Saturday evening/Sunday morning pattern of makeup, hair, and clothes is a wonderful way of restoring order in this very disordered time. As we put on a dress/clothes and heels/shoes, it sets the tone in our mind: I'm devoting this time to worship. Worship requires mental and spiritual preparation, which our physical preparation can enhance. The way we dress has more of an impact on the way we act than we realize. It impacts the way we pray as well.

Moreover, dressing up for Mass even when it's live-streamed or recorded, will help make the mental shift from just hanging around our house to entering into the Eucharistic celebration. If dressing up for Mass isn't a usual practice for you at all, give it a try. Look in the mirror at your best self this weekend - only opportunity these days to get a little fancy!
