CCD 2020-2021

We are almost to the end of August which means winding down of summer and gearing up for the Fall as well as 2020-2021 school year. Although this year with Covid-19 there will be some unique challenges, our teachers are ready to get back to the classrooms and resume the mission of forming our children in faith.

The Sacred Heart-St. Mary's Religious Education Program for Grades 1 – 12, will begin on September 2 and end in May 2021. The classes will run from 7:30 – 8:30 on Wednesday evenings in the South Building/Church Basement. Classes will be conducted with the required Covid-19 guidelines. More information about registering for classes and calendar dates will be emailed to the parents in the coming days.

It is crucial that the parents of our students get involved in the religious education of their children and take an active role in their spiritual development and practice. Our CCD teachers are volunteers who dedicate their time and talent, and sometimes their treasure, to prepare lesson plans and classroom handouts and to conduct various activities to educate the students. I encourage parents to interact with the teachers and offer parental support in the home with a continual review of your student's religious studies and homework. Saint Monica (332-387) August 27

She had smiles for the neighbors, though her husband found her religion and the charity it inspired annoying. She made tearful prayers in private for a son, outwardly self-assured but, as his mother knew, inwardly restless, and whose girlfriend of a dozen years had borne his child out of wedlock. Though not the first or last such mother and son, Monica and Augustine are the Church's most famous, so we keep their feast days back to back, with Monica's, fittingly, first. To Rome she followed Augustine, then to Milan, where years of prayer—and nagging—finally bore fruit in his conversion by Saint Ambrose. For six months, mother and son enjoyed the blessing of rediscovering each other. Just in time! On the way home to North Africa, Monica took sick and died near Rome. No child who has mourned a parent can read, unmoved, Augustine's tender account, in his Confessions, of Monica's last days. At this time of the year, when parents watch apprehensively as children leave for school, may Monica's perseverance and Augustine's long-prayed-for conversion ease anxiety and kindle hope. — Copyright © J.
