Dear Parishioners,

This weekend we celebrate the Pentecost - the descent of the Holy Spirit which is the 3rd glorious mystery of the Rosary. It is the official close of the Easter Season and it's also the birthday of the Church. On this day we commemorate the outpouring of God's Spirit upon the first disciples that empowered them to proclaim the Gospel in word and deed and draw others into the community of faith we call the "Church." As we leave behind the more intense joy of Easter and embrace our mission to continue the work of Jesus, may we call upon the Spirit each day to help us to be faithful followers of Jesus, living in His ways and sharing the Good News of His love to those around us. At the masses last weekend, we distributed the *Novena to the Holy Spirit* prayer cards to the families in our parish. Let us join all the families of our archdiocese to unite in prayer to the Holy Spirit. It is also an opportunity to re-familiarize ourselves with the gifts of the Holy Spirit: The seven-fold gifts of the Holy Spirit are:

Wisdom – gives us a relish for the things of God; directs us to love Him above all things.

Understanding – enables us to know more clearly the great mysteries of our faith.

Counsel – alerts us to the deceits of the devil and dangers to our salvation.

Fortitude – strengthens us to do the will of God; even to die before sin.

Knowledge – equips us to know the will of God in all things.

Godliness (piety) – inspires us to love religion and its practices; stirs us to obey out of love.

Fear of the Lord – fills us with a dread of sin. These are the gifts of the Holy Ghost to the apostles as much as to us; to equip us to do great things for God.

Low-gluten Hosts Available

Dear parishioners, we have now low-gluten hosts (001% or 10ppm gluten) available for parishioners who have wheat-related allergies or intolerances. If you or your child have not been receiving communion because of gluten levels in the hosts you can now request low-gluten hosts at our weekend masses. Please see the priest or the sacristan before Mass to make arrangements. At Communion time, please join the line for the Priest-celebrant of the Mass. He will be holding the container of low-gluten. When you approach him, after you bow to the Blessed Sacrament, request a gluten-free host. The priest will then open the container and allow you to take the host yourself (so there is no cross-contamination with wheat) and receive communion.
